Our hosts since the School began, the Hayes started life as a 19th century gentleman's country residence. Its setting, in the quiet Derbyshire village of *Swanwick*, inspired the School's affectionate soubriquet.

Today, the Hayes remains true to its origins with acres of parkland grounds, lakes, swans, landscaped gardens and afternoon tea and cakes on the lawn.

Yet this is also a thoroughly modern conference centre with large, comfortable meeting rooms and two conference halls (each seating around 400 people), as well as free wireless internet.

The majority of bedrooms include an en-suite shower or bathroom, telephone, hairdryer and tea/coffee making facilities. Ground floor rooms with wheelchair access are also available (see inside for full accommodation details). All meals are included in the cost of your stay.
